3			<i>Snow Shoe Dash</i>			Scouts wearing homemade snow shoes sprint a 6 x 20 yard relay. One pair is swapped between patrol members.
4	Troop 131	Wrentham	<i>Snow Snake</i>	Vern Palango		From a running start, Scouts throw a six foot long hand crafted stick from a starting line into a hard packed snow or ice trough. The farthest gliding throw wins
5	Troop 99	Franklin	<i>2-Man Log Saw</i>	Chris Miga		Two patrol members at a time swap off in relay style to remove the end of a log.
6	Troop 42	Norwood	<i>Flint + Steel</i>	John Pooley		Patrols build a fire lay and spark the fire which burns through the string that releases the "egg" that falls into the bucket of hot water that is fetched in the ladle that is brought to the judge.
7	Pack 131	Wrentham	<i>Hoop + Spear</i>	Alan Plantamura		Eight scouts take turns throwing two spears through rolling hoops
8	Troop 49	Norwood	<i>Chilkoot Pass</i>	Clifford Firth (SM)		
9	Troop 80	Norfolk	<i>Hawk Throw</i>	Mark Andrade (SM) Kevin Cronin		Eight Scouts throws two hawks (rubber mallets) to knock down milk jugs.
10			<i>Turkey Shoot</i>			Eight Scouts take aim at cast iron frying pans with slings and dried dog food nuggets.
11	Troop 126	Franklin	<i>Cross the Creek</i>	Bill Murphy (SM)		Patrols must quickly bring their patrol across a river with ice flows in the shortest time.
12			<i>Attack on Fort Russell</i>			Patrols must race to scale the walls of Fort Russell hauling themselves, sled and gear over the wall.
13	Troop 100	Bellingham	<i>Ravine Rescue</i>	Candy Martel (SM) Doug Urmston (ASM)		Scouts give first aid and rescue "victim" from ravine with rope.
14			<i>D. Boone Killed a Bear</i>			Scouts throw a rope over a suspended "limb" 20 feet off the ground. Tie the rope to a 20 pound bear sack. Haul it into the air and tie it off.
15			<i>Smooshboard/Bi-Athalon</i>			Patrol members' right feet are tied to one long 2x4; left feet to another. Patrol is timed in walking a course on flat ground
16			<i>Co-op Mouse Trap</i>			A spiderweb of rope support magnets. The ropes are guided over a field of metal lids that are attracted to the magnets. Scouts use teamwork to capture as many of the lids as possible.
